Arizona Department of Transportation extends AZ Travel ID deadline

Thursday, March 26, 2020

The Oct. 1 deadline for the new federal TSA REAL ID rules to take effect has been delayed ONE YEAR

to Oct. 1, 2021. As a result, MVD customers should postpone plans to get the AZ Travel ID. With this

delay and the need to reduce customer traffic at MVD locations, all AZ Travel ID appointments have

been canceled. ADOT apologizes for the inconvenience, but the ongoing coronavirus situation

requires MVD to significantly limit the number of people in offices. Only essential services that must

be done in-person are being offered by appointment. Because the REAL ID timeline has changed,

getting a Travel ID immediately is less vital for the time being and appointments are reserved for

other crucial in-person services. More than 2/3 of MVD services are available anytime

at www.servicearizona.com. REMINDER: Anyone with a license or permit set to expire between

March 1 and Sept. 1 has had that expiration date automatically extended by six months and updated

on your motor vehicle record. You do not need to get a new license. For more information,
