

Coronavirus update – March 22, 2021 - Some Meeting Rooms, Libraries to reopen April 5

Monday, March 22, 2021

As promised in last week's *PebbleNews*, we are now able to share the details about some meetings rooms, the two sports buildings and both our libraries being open again for use beginning April 5.

The details are below:

Meeting Rooms

The following Meetings Rooms in the Tuscan Falls and Eagle's Nest Clubhouses and in the Activities Complex will be open for reservation, beginning April 5, with protocols and capacity limits in place. **Please note that clubs that requested meeting room dates will receive an email with a reminder of their confirmed dates for 2021.**

Please note for all spaces noted in this communication, the use of face masks and maintaining social distance of at least six feet is still in place. We do understand that when seated at a meeting room table, there is not six feet, this is the choice of each individual. We ask that you do not move any furniture, and do not add chairs to any tables. Water fountains will be turned on again as of April 5 in both clubhouses. Please also note that Food and Beverage options for service, i.e., muffins, coffee, beverage stations, bar service, etc. for these rooms is unavailable until further notice.

- Palermo Room – 24 people maximum; (6) four-top tables
- Sienna Room – 24 people maximum; (6) four-top tables
- Capri Room – 20 people maximum; (5) four-top tables

- Milan Room – 20 people maximum; (5) four-top tables
- Billiards Room – Please contact the Billiards Club for their HOA approved reopening guidelines and capacity limits
- Palm Room – 36 people maximum; (9) four-top tables
- Room 100 – 10 people maximum; (1) large conference table

Please note that the Chianti Room and Chianti South Meeting Rooms are not part of this phase of re-opening, and will remain unavailable for meetings until further notice, as these rooms will substitute for Toscana's during the restaurant remodel. Neither of the Ballrooms will open for use at this time, as large gatherings are not yet approved. Any reservations requests for rooms that are not already part of the regular reservations already requested last year can be made by calling the Activities Office (623-535-9854) beginning April

1. Please do not call for reservations before that time.

Renaissance Theater

The Renaissance Theater will be available for rehearsals only (with very specific protocols and capacity limits) for the four Performing Arts Council (PAC) Groups only at this time. No concerts or other events will occur at this time. Specific details and guidelines will be provided to the (PAC) Club Presidents and PAC Moderator.

Sports Buildings

The Sports Buildings will be available for reservations under the same guidelines as had been prior to COVID-19 restrictions.

- Eagle's Nest Sports Building - (12) people maximum; (3) four-top tables
- Tuscany Falls Sports Building – (16) people maximum; (4) four- top tables

Libraries

The Libraries at both Eagle's Nest and Tuscany Falls Clubhouses will be open April 5. Please
