Patrol modifies some services to meet social distancing guidelines

Due to issues related to Coronavirus closures, some services that Patrol normally offers may

be temporarily interrupted, or unavailable, depending on staffing availability. We are doing

everything we can to continue normal operations, but there are challenges. Some services

previously offered require closer contact, and thus if we continue, would cause us to violate

social distancing recommendations. So there are some modifications we must make to

continue to offer certain services. One service example is golf cart tows. We will still offer

this service, but during this time, the owner of the cart will now be required to be present

when the cart is picked up and again, when it is delivered. The person needing the tow will

need to make arrangements to get from point "A" to point "B" as we can not allow anyone

to ride on our Patrol vehicles with our staff. As needed, we will continue to update you on

any other services that may need modifications or to be stopped. As a reminder, our patrol

office remains closed to foot traffic. The number of calls for assistance has increased

recently, and will most likely continue to increase over the next month or two. Please have

patience when you call. We are doing our best to respond as soon as possible. For
