

# Vaccine questions for the HOA; what we know today

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Members of your HOA staff have begun to receive questions about whether or not PebbleCreek will become a vaccine administration site. Here is what we know at this time. Many of you may know that KareBears facilitates bringing the flu shot to PebbleCreek, through a relationship with Walgreens. With that in mind, HOA staff did reach out to find out if it was possible for the Covid-19 vaccine to be delivered in a similar manner. At this time, vaccine providers, like Walgreens, are not set up to have remote site locations. In addition, a staffer reached out to a CIGNA Medical Group location in the area and they indicated that currently they do not even have the infrastructure or training for their own medical professionals to begin administering the vaccine in their location. In addition they have not even received any supplies of the vaccine yet, nor could they say when they would be receiving it. So at this time, we do not have any opportunities for onsite vaccine administration.
